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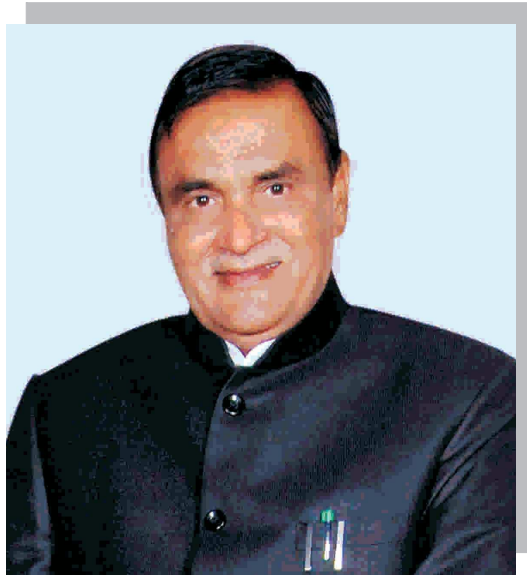
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Late Sh. Mukesh Kumar Gautam

The Curriculum

The Foundation stage is for children in the Reception class and is designed to be a comfortable bridge between Nursery and upper classes and the slightly more formal and structured environment of school. It provides a broad curriculum based on the three prime and four specific areas of learning and development.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (Prime Area)

Making relationships : self confidence and self awareness; managing feelings and behaviour.

Physical Development (Prime Area)

Moving and handling; health and self care.

Communication and Language (Prime Area)

Listening and attention; understanding; speaking.

Literacy (Specific Area)

Reading and writing

Mathematics (Specific Area)

Numbers, shapes, space and measure.

Understanding the world (Specific Area)

People and Communication; the world; technology.

Expressive arts and design (Specific Area)

Exploring and using media and materials; being imaginative.

The curriculum of the school is what is taught and how it is taught currently based on the National curriculum which includes provision for the core subjects.

We believe that the education of young children is best seen as a whole and much of our planning and teaching centres on themes and modules and we take every opportunity to develop ideas and themes. We take great care to ensure that all aspects of each subject are covered and no important content and no key skills are missed.
